USE:	Toxicant formulation for killing ants. Contains Boric Acid Cas No. 10043-35-3 80 g/litre & Sodium Borate Cas No. 12179-04-3 56 g/litre
APPEARANCE:	Odourless green liquid.
HEALTH EFFECTS:	No adverse health effects expected if the product is handled in accordance with the safety data sheet and the product label. Acute effects if the product is mishandled. This product may be harmful if swallowed and can result in nausea, vomiting and diarrhoea. <u>EYES:</u> May be an eye irritant. <u>SKIN:</u> Extended contact with skin may result in mild irritation. It is unlikely that harmful quantities can be absorbed.
